Honouring Play

An individual that has demonstrated creativity by initiating new ideas in programming (curriculum), use of resources and enriching the lives of children through play. The nominee uses reflective practices, focuses on children's natural curiosity and exuberance and has embedded the early childhood setting with rich learning opportunities.

Embracing All Children: Must be a Registered ECE

An individual who demonstrates exemplary respect for diversity, equity and inclusion. The nominee has embraced the unique life experiences, orientations and developmental abilities of ALL children. This individual has encouraged and motivated others with a team approach, sustained a positive attitude and creatively provided an environment to support others.
